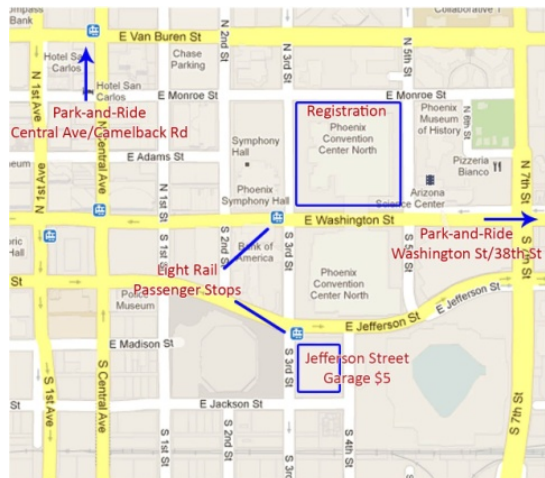

Location

Registration and sessions for Fall Leadership Conference will be at the Phoenix Convention Center (PCC), North Building. The entrance to the registration area is E Monroe Street between N 3rd Street and N 5th Street.

Parking

Parking is on your own. The Jefferson Street Garage has offered our group a \$5 parking rate. The 4th Street entrance can accommodate oversized vehicles.

We also suggest utilizing the METRO Light Rail by dropping participants off at the PCC and sending your vehicle to park in a **free** Park-and-Ride lot. The closest lots are 38th Street/Washington Street or Central Avenue/Camelback Road.

The fee to ride the Light Rail is \$3.50 for an all day pass. The passenger stop for the PCC is 3rd Street/Washington (Westbound) or 3rd Street /Jefferson (Eastbound)

Business Professional Attire or Official Dress

Students and advisors are required to dress professionally. Suggested attire includes:

- Dress slacks with a button down shirt or polo. A dress skirt and blouse is acceptable for females.
- Official CTSO attire as outlined by SkillsUSA

The following are not permitted: t-shirts, shorts, mini-skirts, thin-strap tank tops, jeans, torn clothing, baggy pants, "skinny" pants, cargo pants, and flip flops.

Agenda & Lunch

During student sessions, students do not change rooms. Presenters will rotate so all students participate in all four sessions. Students must remain in their assigned rooms during session times.

Advisors will have a SkillsUSA update and informational sessions to attend.

Lunch is on your own. A map of nearby dining options will be available at registration.

Please make arrangements to stay for the entire FLC experience. Closing Session and Keynote will conclude at 3:30PM.
