Arrival & Departure

Registration will open at 1 PM. **Please do not arrive at camp before this time.** During registration you will receive name badges, certificates, t-shirts, and cabin assignments. You may take care of any substitutions at this time. Please keep substitutes male-for-male or female-for-female (substitutes of a different gender will be taken but cannot be guaranteed rooming with the rest of your group). The last session on Friday will conclude by 11 AM.

Location—Lost Canyon Camp

From I-40, take Exit #163 to Grand Canyon Blvd. Follow GC Blvd. south to the 2nd stop sign. Turn right onto Railroad Ave. Continue for 2 blocks and turn left onto 4th St. Follow 4th St. south out of town. 4th St. becomes Perkinsville Rd. Take this road a total of 1.9 miles (past the reservoir) until you see the left turn lane and a green “Lost Canyon” road sign. Turn left onto the camp road and drive to the parking area near the gate and main office. There is plenty of parking at the camp facility.

Schedule and Sessions

Students and advisors will be expected to attend their designated sessions as assigned on their name badge, once they arrive to camp.
